Subject: Debt Capital Market Issuance Disclosure Practice – Guidance on Price and Tenor

Following consideration by the AFMA Credit Product Committee of market feedback on debt capital market issuance disclosure requirements, it has been resolved to recommend as good practice broad and consistent dissemination of price and tenor guidance. The objective is to have consistent disclosure practice in Australia. This provides market participants the same access to disclosure regarding potential primary market trades.

Disclosure Practice – Guidance on Price and Tenor

Where an issuer has sanctioned price and tenor guidance, before this information is shared other than under an official wall crossing, disclosure of price and tenor is to be made to the broad market through a media release¹:

For the avoidance of doubt, the distribution to investors of readily available public information such as secondary pricing or comparable issuance pricing in markets is acceptable practice under the current mandate announcement language.
